STAGING REGULATIONS

Competitors unable to fulfil their commitments must notify the Committee in advance of the Show. There will be no refund of the Registration Fee, Competition Entry Fee, or Imposed Class

1. All competitive classes must be **STAGED IN SITU** by the competitor on Wednesday 2 October 2019.
2. Competitors may only use **PRE-CONSTRUCTED OR PRE-WOVEN PLANT MATERIAL** which does not constitute the dominant component of the design unless they have entered Class 2 Craft Section or Class 4 the Contemporary Design.
3. Any pre-constructed components must be cleared with the Steward on duty **before staging** commences.
4. Plant material must predominate unless otherwise stated in the schedule.
5. Dried, bleached, preserved and skeletonised plant material is considered natural.
6. **Please note** candles may be included but not lit due to fire regulations. Battery operated lights are allowed.
7. Competitors' name tags **MUST** be worn at all times.
8. Only competitors and officials will be allowed in the halls during staging times.
9. All exhibits will be staged in artificial lighting. The staging time for competitive exhibits will be enforced from 08h00 – 16h00 on Wednesday 2 October 2019. Any competitor working on their exhibit after 16h00 on the day of staging **will be disqualified**.
10. No component of the arrangements may be removed after judging has taken place.
11. **IMPOSED CLASS 5.** All materials to be supplied by the Show Committee.
 - a. Competitors to report at the entrance to the Impala Room at 12h45 on Wednesday 2 October 2019. Doors will open at 13h00 to commence staging.
 - b. Time allowance 13h00 – 16h00
 - c. Please bring scissors/secateurs/knife only.
 - d. Competitors will not be allowed access to the hall prior to this time.
12. No help may be given regarding preparation or construction of an exhibit except if required to lift a heavy object, and only then at the discretion of a Show Official/Steward.
13. All exhibits must be staged within the space provided, using the specified staging, unless otherwise indicated in the schedule. Attachments to and moving of staging is **NOT PERMITTED**. Exhibits that exceed the allocated space will be penalised. The show committee reserves the right to position entries at their discretion. **Class 1 – Box/Crate** may be positioned according to competitors' choice.
14. Competitors must place their waste material in refuse bags which they must supply and remove from the hall and premises.
15. **NO** aerosol / spray painting is **PERMITTED** in the halls or surrounding areas/premises.

16. For competitors wishing to use electrical equipment, e.g. glue gun, please note that the supply is 220W in the designated areas. Competitors to supply their own glue gun, or electrical equipment.
17. Judging will be conducted on Thursday, 3 October 2019, at 09h00. It will be conducted according to the South African Flower Union Handbook for Judges and Flower Arrangers, 2017.
18. No persons other than the Judges, their Stewards and the Show Officials will be permitted in the halls whilst judging is in progress.
19. In addition to **BEST ON SHOW** Award and other Special Prizes, prizes will be presented to 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each class or as otherwise stated.
20. Competitors are required to maintain their exhibits in prime condition for the duration of the show. **Maintenance** of exhibits may be carried out from 07h00 – 07h30 from Friday 4 October 2019 to Sunday 6 October 2019. Prizemoney may be withheld if prizewinning exhibit is not maintained in pristine condition.
21. Competitors are responsible for their own property and own insurance if deemed necessary. Neither Safari Lifestyle Garden Centre nor the Show organisers accept any liability for loss or damage to any of the competitors' property.
22. **NO ARRANGEMENT MAY BE DISMANTLED BEFORE THE TIME STIPULATED IN THIS SCHEDULE.** Any exhibit or part thereof remaining unattended in the halls after 12h00 on Monday 7 October 2019 will be deemed abandoned and will be disposed of.
23. Class 2 (Craft Section) will not be eligible for 'Best on Show'.

JUDGING

- Judging will be done according to the English/Afrikaans version of the 2017 SAFU Handbook for Judges and Flower Arrangers.
- The Judges will use the Ribbon System.
- Each class will be judged according to its own individual title.
- **For research purposes use of all available resources such as dictionaries, thesauruses as well as the internet.**

CLASS INFORMATION

Class 1: A Table Design - OLIFANT ROOM

Title ***'Inside Out, Or Outside In...'***

- Staged: on a wooden table 900mm x 900mm covered with a cream table cloth
- **STAGING SUPPLIED** – A NATURAL WOODEN BOX/CRATE to be incorporated in your design.
- This box remains the property of Safari Lifestyle Garden Centre. Competitor to avoid any damage to the box/crate.
- **Box/Crate may be positioned according to competitors' choice.**
- Box/crate measurements - Width 270mm, Length 430mm, Depth 270mm – openings between planks 20mm – (3 planks make up each side with two gaps between).
- Allocated space: Width 900mm, Depth 900mm, Height Optional.
- Prize Money: 1st R600, 2nd R400, 3rd R200



Class 2: Pre-Done Craft Section - OLIFANT ROOM

TITLE ***'Trendy Ethnic Adornments'*** Headgear, Neck and Wrist

- Staged: on a black board supplied by competitor.
- Competitor to choose own black board, either fabric or painted.
- Size of Board - Width 400mm, Length 500mm.
- Items to be firmly attached to the board.
- The Show Committee will display these boards at their discretion at an advantageous angle on a table.
- Viewed and judged from the front.
- Prize Money: 1st R600, 2nd R400, 3rd R200

Class 3: A Table Design – WATERBOK ROOM

Title ***‘Twice as Nice’***

- Staged: on a trestle table width 900mm, depth 900mm covered with a pale grey table cloth.
- Allocated space: Width 900mm, Depth 900mm, Height Optional
- Judged from the front but viewed all round
- Prize Money: 1st R600, 2nd R400, 3rd R200

Class 4: A Contemporary Design - WATERBOK ROOM

Title ***‘Quintessentially Now’***

PRE-CONSTRUCTED OR PRE-WOVEN PLANT MATERIAL IS ALLOWED AND MAY BE DOMINANT

- Staged: On a supplied base Width 900mm, Depth 900mm painted RED Plascon colour swatch RED FLAME R7-A1-1
- Allocated space: Width 1000mm, Depth 1000mm, Height Optional
- Judged from the front but viewed all round
- Prize Money: 1st R1000, 2nd R750, 3rd R500

Class 5: An Imposed Box Design – IMPALA ROOM

Title ***‘Structural Challenge’***

- Staged: on a conference table - oak melamine finish
- Conference table specification: Width 1200mm Depth 720mm
- All materials to be supplied by the Show Committee.
- Please bring scissors/secateurs/knife only.
- A table with sundry mechanics, tools, glue gun etc will be available.
- Judged from the front but viewed all round.
- Prize Money: 1st R600, 2nd R400, 3rd R200

Class 6: A Free-Standing Design - KUDU ROOM

Designer Of The Year 2019 (SAFU MEMBERS ONLY)

Title – ***‘State Of The Art’***

- Staged: on a supplied base Width 900mm, Depth 900mm painted PINK Plascon colour swatch FUSCIA FIZZ R2-A1-1.
- Allocated space: Width 1000mm, Depth 1000mm, Height Optional
- Judged from the front but viewed all round.
- Prize Money: 1st R1 000, 2nd R750, 3rd R500

Class 7: A Table Design - KUDU ROOM

Title ***'The Calm Before The Storm'***

- Staged: on a wooden table 900mm x 900mm covered with a pale grey table cloth.
- Competitor may supply their own cloth or runner.
- Allocated space: Width 950mm, Depth 950mm, Height Optional
- Judged from the front but viewed all round.
- Prize Money: 1st R600, 2nd R400, 3rd R200

Class 8: A Petite Exhibit - KUDU ROOM

Title ***'Dancing on Ice'***

- Staged: on a table with staging brought to eye-level, approximately 1200mm - 1300mm. Design will be staged on a glass plate measuring 320mm in diameter, see photo below. Table to be covered with a pale grey tablecloth.
- Allocated Space: Width 250mm, Depth 250mm, height 250mm.
- Judged and viewed from the front.
- Prize Money: 1st R400, 2nd R300, 3rd R200



Class 9: A Mobile Design - KUDU PATIO

Title ***'Space Odyssey'***

- Staged: under thatch roofing in an opening. Width 1500mm, Height 900mm,
- Allocated Space: Width 1200mm, Height 500mm
- Maximum weight 1kg
- Competitor will be supplied with 1 x Brass hook already in place, with fishing line and a swivel loop to attach your design.
- Judged and viewed from the front.
- Prize Money: 1st R600, 2nd R400, 3rd R200

Class 10: A Waterwise Design - WATERBOK PATIO – Under a roof but exposed to all elements. Competitors encouraged to use succulents/waterwise plant material.

Title ***'Save our Planet'***

- Staged: in a cement pot to be supplied by the nursery of Safari Lifestyle Centre - see photo below.
- Pot Measurements: Outside Base width 350mm, height 650mm. Opening width and depth 400mm of pot. Colour light tan.
- Competitors' will also receive 2/3 bags of potting soil in plastic to raise the level to your design mechanics. A sheet of plastic will be supplied to protect the pot from any damage. The pot remains the property of Safari Lifestyle Centre.
- Allocated Space: Width 1000mm, Depth 1000mm Height optional.
- Judged from the front but viewed all round.
- Prize Money: 1st R600, 2nd R400, 3rd R200
